She was born Abt. 1820 in AL<sup>6</sup>, and died Aft. 1860.

2. Wes Patterson, Amos sold his land in Rusk Co TX on 2-26-1861. No other known record of him after 1861 has been found yet.

4. Rusk Co., Tx Marriages, Amos remarried in Rusk Co., Tx in Sept 1858 to a Pamela A. Morris.
5. Rusk Co Tx Records, "Pamelia" A. Morris married Amos Patterson in Rusk Co Tx on 9-12-1858. "Parmelia" was in Amos' household in the 1860 Rusk Co Tx census. There were two younger children (10 & 8) with the last name of Morris, so I believe that Morris was the married name of Parmelia by her first husband, who must have died before 1852-1858, and her maiden name must have started with an "A", but I don't know what that was.

8. Census Records, The 1834 census lists Amos with five males and two females. This would indicate either a 4th son and the oldest daughter being born by 1834, or it could be that Amos's parents (John and Margaret Black Patterson) were living with them in 1834 Union Co., Ga. The 1850 Gilmer Co., Ga census lists Mary M. as 15 years old.

12. Wes Patterson, The records of Rusk Co Tx only note W. L. Patterson or Lumpkin Patterson or Wilson L. Patterson (Civil War records). I am beginning to think that his name was Wilson Lumpkin Patterson instead of William Lumpkin Patterson. Afterall, his mother was a WILSON.WP, Dec. 2004.
